Building good working relationships with your teaching staff is the key to being a good Student Rep.

Liaise with your course leader and other teaching staff as much as you can. Be proactive and arrange to meet with them regularly. If you don't wish to liaise with your course leader for any reason or feel the matter needs escalating, then go to the Head of Student Experience and Academic Outcomes for your school.
